# **50 YEAR LEGACY**

In 1973, three mothers and parishioners of St. John the Baptist Catholic Church in New Freedom met after masses to have their young children play. Recognizing a local need for socialization and instruction before kindergarten, Alice Peirmatteos, Kathy Paddock, and Peggy Keller of New Freedom and Shrewsbury met at Alice's house one afternoon with the idea of starting a preschool.

Through church support, local partnerships, and focused determination, a curriculum was obtained from Southern Elementary School in Glen Rock for St. John the Baptist Preschool to open its doors at Neumann Hall in January of 1974. The first class consisted of one teacher and twelve students.

Today, St. John the Baptist Preschool has over sixty students enrolled and continues the legacy of Alice, Kathy, and Peggy by offering instruction through hands-on learning experiences, music, prayer, and play. Preschool students were excited to have a special guest reader this April, Peggy Keller, the last surviving of the three founding mothers.
